2005 Maintenance Budget

GARBAGE PICK UP

Do you get confused about what day your garbage and recycling will be picked up??????? Autumn Heights is on a weekly Wednesday pick up schedule for both trash and recycling. The only time there is NOT a Wednesday pick up is when a holiday (Christmas, New Years, Thanksgiving and Fourth of July) land on a Monday of the week. Since Christmas and New Year are on a weekend our pick up service will NOT be affected. Recycling is done every other Wednesday (odd weeks) Remaining recycling dates are: October 26, November 2, 16, 30 & December 14 & 28th.

PLEASE put your trash and recycling out **ONLY** on trash pick up day and don't forget to take it in the same day. By putting your trash out a day/night early we invite wild animals into our neighborhood and the trash receptacles. Trash receptacles are to be stored in your garage and are not allowed on the driveway except for trash days.

Please follow these rules. A warning letter will be sent in the event trash is put out early and not put away after pick up. Thanks for your cooperation!

Winter Parking

We continue to struggle with not enough parking for visitors to our community. With winter right around the corner we find it important to reiterate the communities parking rules.

- No parking on the side of the road. These are all posted fire lanes. Homeowner's may call the Colorado Springs Police Department to report an illegally parked vehicle.
- Advise your guests to park in the overflow parking areas. Visitors are also allowed to park on Broadmoor Bluffs.
- Homeowner's with short driveways are NOT to park their cars with part of the car on the driveway and part on the road. These cars will be considered illegally parked and can be reported to the Colorado Springs Police Department for ticketing and towing.

Energy Costs continue to rise as the temperatures drop. Here are some tips from Colorado Springs Utilities to help prepare your home for winter:

- Wrap your hot water heater with an approved thermal blanket and turn down the thermostat.
- Install a programmable thermostat that will automatically adjust your temperature settings for certain times of the day and week.
- Check your front doors for gaps. Have the weather strip adjusted to minimize cold air into the home.

Storing firewood outside is not allowed. Firewood should be stored in your garage or storage areas.



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


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
